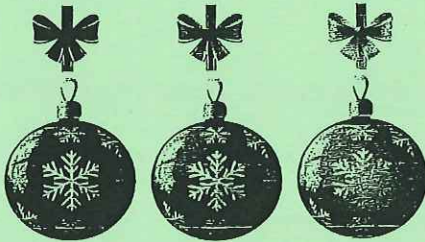
DETAILS for ACTIVITIES
